Thank you for your interest in taking the ASBOG examination(s). Beginning in March 2023, the ASBOG examinations will be computer-based; all candidates will sit for the exams at an approved Prometric testing center. This will require registration to be different than it has been in the past. We will need just a little bit of information from you to get you "pre-registered".

Please email me the following information: First Name, Last Name, email address and if you are wanting to register for the Fundamentals of Geology or Practice of Geology. **Your deadline register with the Board is Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>.** We will take that information and upload it to Prometric for you. The fees are as follows: \$200.00 for the Fundamentals of Geology Exam, \$250.00 for the Practice of Geology Exam and a \$75.00 set fee is accessed for each part of the exam. These fees are not regulated by the Board.

Your contact information will allow Prometric to contact you directly to schedule when and where you would like to take your test and then allow you to make your payment online directly. That e-mail will come approximately 6 weeks prior to the test date of March 17, 2023. Please check your junk/spam mailboxes, as the email will not be arriving from Hope Childers, Board Administrator as it has in the past.

**Please be aware that sending this information does NOT schedule your test, you will do that when the e-mail is received from Prometric / ASBOG 6 weeks prior to the testing date.**

The Fall Examination is scheduled for Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, with a registration deadline of Tuesday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>.
